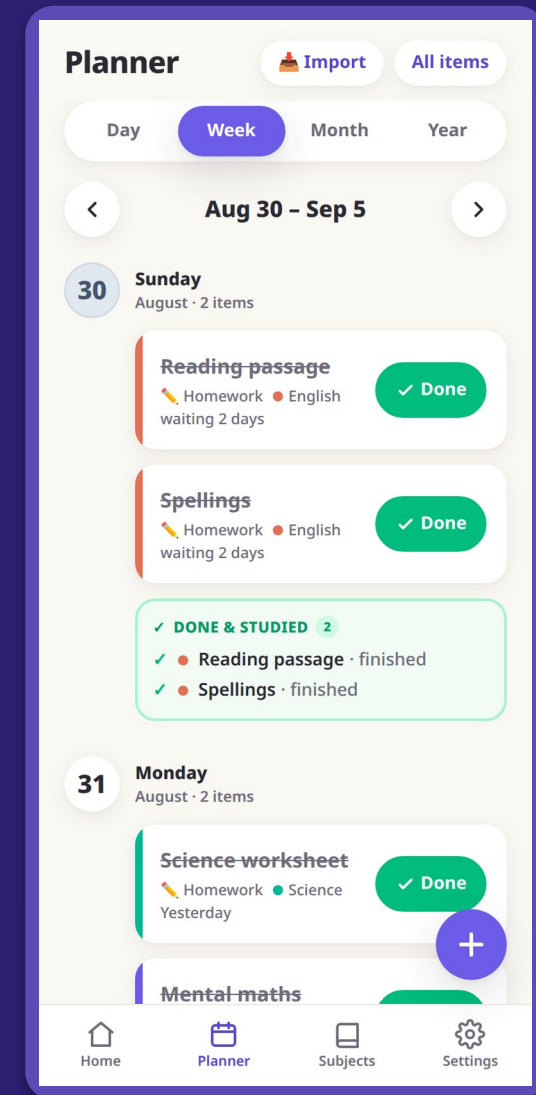
The parent is paying for those fifteen minutes too.

THE PARENT INVITES YOU

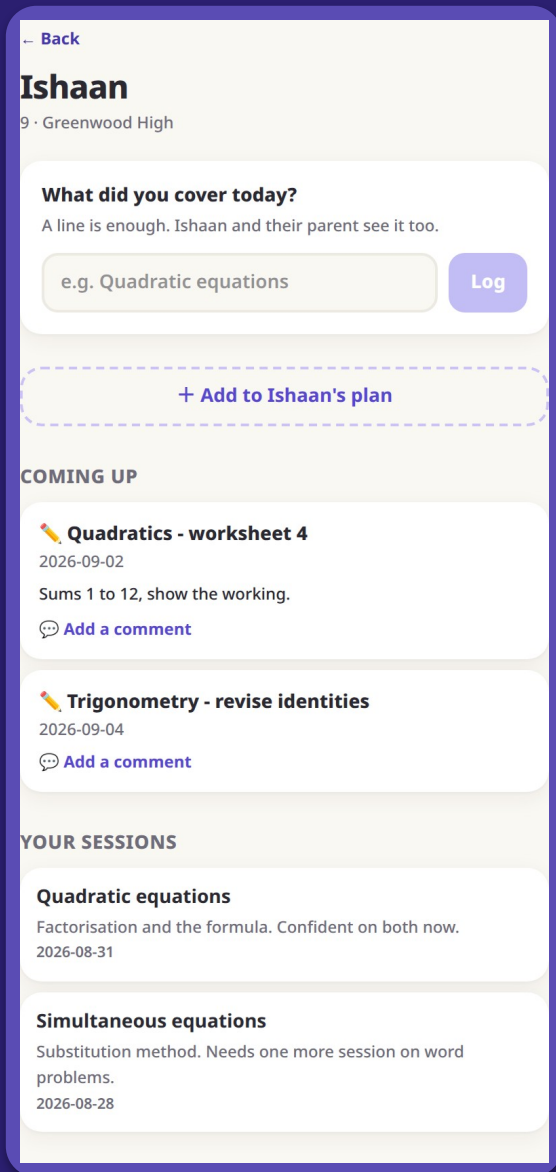
Their school week, and nothing else about them.

You are not asked to install anything, and there is no account to set up before you can see it. You accept the invitation and the week is there.

You open the hour already knowing where they are.

Quadratics worksheet due Wednesday, trigonometry to revise, term exams three weeks out. You plan the session around the week the child is actually having, not the one you assumed.

What you set goes into the same list, beside the school's work rather than in a notebook of yours they will lose. One list, and you are on it.

AFTER EVERY SESSION

~~“So what did you cover today?”~~

~~“Is he actually improving?”~~

~~“Do we keep going next term?”~~

One line, and the parent stops wondering.

You write what you covered, and a line is enough. The child sees it, and so does the parent who is paying for the hour.

15 minutes back, every hour

That is the quarter of the session you were spending on “what did Miss set?”, now spent teaching. It is also why the tuition continues: a parent renews what they can see working, and most tutors are judged on a marksheet that arrives months late.

You are never rated, ranked or compared with another tutor. There is no leaderboard anywhere in AllSet, for children or for you.

WHAT IT COSTS YOU

Your first family is free.

The family's plan carries you. You join free when a parent invites you, and you stay free for as long as you teach that child. There is nothing to buy to accept an invitation, nothing to cancel, and no card to put in.

Beyond that first family, one subscription at ₹249 a month covers every family you tutor and every class you teach, however many there are. That is also the plan if you run your own batches: your own roster, your own announcements.

No advertising, no profiling, and no one will ever call you.

THIS WEEK · ONE STUDENT

Ask one parent to invite you.

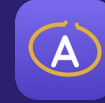
Pick the student whose week you most often have to reconstruct. The invitation comes from their parent, and it takes them a minute.
